 - 2. Was God lonely before he created? Does God need anything from his creation?
- 4. What characteristic of God have you seen most clearly thus far in Exodus? Or which is most dear to you? See the outline on back of this page.
- 5. What is the significance of John 8:56-58?
 - 1. Consider John 1:1-3, 14; John 17:5, 24
 - 2. What do these verses tell us about Jesus?
- 6. It has been said we cannot really know ourselves without knowing God.
 - 1. How does the attributes and character of God help you understand yourself?
 - 2. Consider that you are created in his image as you ponder this. Consider the impact of the fall.

- I. God is compassionate. (2:23-24a)
- II. God is faithful. (2:24)
- III. God is holy. (3:5)
- IV. God is self-existent. (3:14)

- VII. God is all-knowing. (3:19)
- VIII. God is all-powerful. (vv. 3:20-22)
